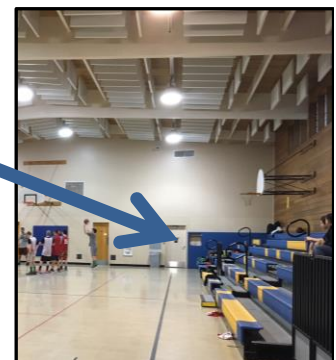


2001 SWEET HOME SCHOOL DISTRICT BOND SPENDING RECAP

What projects were paid for with the 2001 bond?

The 2001 bond proceeds totaled \$18,674,314. An additional \$1,193,312 in interest was earned on the bond proceeds. The total amount of \$19,867,626 paid for the following:

- High school reconstruction including a new library, commons area, cafeteria, kitchen, offices, front entrance, some main building classrooms, restrooms and parking lot improvements = \$8,316,879
- New high school gymnasium building including main gym, wrestling gym, weight room, locker rooms, restrooms and entrance lobby = \$4,407,778
- District-wide heating and ventilation upgrades and related asbestos removal = \$2,089,216
- Hawthorne Elementary addition of eight new classroom = \$1,181,933
- Swimming pool improvements including mechanical systems, locker room and entrance upgrades = \$861,917
- District-wide roofing projects = \$697,796
- District-wide restroom improvements and ADA compliance improvements = \$631,738
- District-wide electrical system upgrades = \$442,625
- District-wide blacktop/concrete repairs = \$282,858
- District-wide underground oil storage tank removal and environmental cleanup = \$216,924
- Covered elementary playground structures at Hawthorne, Oak Heights, Crawfordsville and Holley schools = \$142,066
- District-wide fire and security alarms = \$133,016
- District-wide control system improvements for heating and lighting systems = \$117,170
- Auditorium seating repairs/improvements = \$90,343
- Bond issuance costs = \$41,273
- Junior high hall lockers = \$37,768
- Junior high gym bleachers = \$32,997
- Asbestos sampling and floor tile replacement = \$24,930
- District-wide intercom system improvements = \$22,666
- Foster Elementary gym bleachers = \$21,339
- Foster gym siding = \$17,614
- Well and water system repairs = \$13,726
- District-wide window replacements = \$11,543
- District-wide emergency lights = \$10,421
- Storage during construction = \$7,519
- District-wide bells, clocks and related wiring = \$4,877
- Foster health room construction = \$4,542
- Plumbing repairs = \$4,152



In addition, LBCC paid \$500,000 for the LBCC center on the Sweet Home High School campus. This space reverts to the high school after 30 years of LBCC use.
