_____ **OREGON SCHOOL EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP**

- One parent or guardian must be employed with Sweet Home School District as a classified staff member (OSEA Chapter 3 union member)
- Can be used at any accredited school
- Must have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA

_____ **SWEET HOME EDUCATION ASSOCIATION**

- One parent must be a current or retired employee with Sweet Home School District as a certified staff member
- Available to graduating seniors and alumni
- Can be used at any accredited school

Criteria for Scholarships

AWARD AMOUNT:

- May vary based on specific scholarship. Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, books and/or fees at an accredited community college, college, university or technical school in the United States.

WHO MAY APPLY?

- Sweet Home High School or other qualifying graduating seniors that have a parent who works for the Sweet Home School District as a certified or classified employee. Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 for the SHEA scholarship and a minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA for the OSEA scholarship.

CONDITIONS OF AWARDS:

- Each applicant must have been accepted to an accredited community college, college, university or technical school in the United States. The student must be enrolled at the time the scholarship is dispersed.
- The Scholarship award will be sent to the educational institution at the beginning of the academic year. The institution will disperse the award in equal allotments based upon that institutions academic year. (i.e. semester/quarter).
- If for any reason the recipient of this award is not able to attend the educational institution for any part of the year for which the award is made, all unused monies awarded will be returned to the scholarship committees or may be made available to an alternate recipient.
- Applicants need to have completed the FAFSA forms prior to enrollment at the accredited community college, college, university or technical school.

COMPLETED APPLICATION INCLUDES:

- Scholarship application form (MUST be typed or neatly handwritten in pen)
- Two letters of reference from non-family members. Please ensure that they include contact address and phone number as well as relationship and number of years of acquaintance.
- Resume that lists all activities student has participated in during the past four years and awards or honors received including work history, community, school, church, leadership experiences, participation in specific organizations, skills, hobbies, interests and any other extra-curricular activities.
- Copy of High School Transcripts through first semester.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

- Applications may be submitted to the Sweet Home High School Career Center at any time. All applications **must** be received before **April 30th of the current year.** **INCOMPLETE OR LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

NOTIFICATION TO APPLICANTS:

- Recipients of scholarships will be announced at the Sweet Home High School Awards Ceremony in June.
