Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be graduating high school students, live in the Sweet Home School District geographic area, and have resided here for the previous two years. They should have an excellent academic record. They must be able to demonstrate that they have reached out to others through school service, community service or through promotion of world peace through international cooperation and understanding.

Sweet Home Rotary Club does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, gender, national or ethnic origin in the administration of the scholarship program or any other administered programs.

Required:

- 3.00 cumulative GPA minimum
- Completed scholarship application
- Unofficial copy of transcript
- Resume, including academic, service, work experience and honors information
- Two scholarship recommendation forms (pages 6 & 7): no more than one should be from a school employee; one should preferably be from a person for whom you have volunteered.

Note:

- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Interview will be required for finalists.
