## Q&A

Can my child continue to wear a mask in some or all classes?

- **Yes.** Wearing a face mask on Mar. 14 is optional for all students and staff.

Will my child need to wear a mask on the school bus?

- **No.** Wearing a face mask on the school bus is also optional starting on Mar. 14.

If there is an exposure to COVID-19 in my child's class will I be notified?

- **Yes.** If there is an exposure across multiple classes, cohorts, or bus routes, then the parents/guardians of all affected children across classes and cohorts will be notified by the school.

Will my student need to quarantine if exposed to COVID-19 at school?

- **No,** as long as your child does not test positive or have symptoms of COVID-19, they will not need to quarantine.
