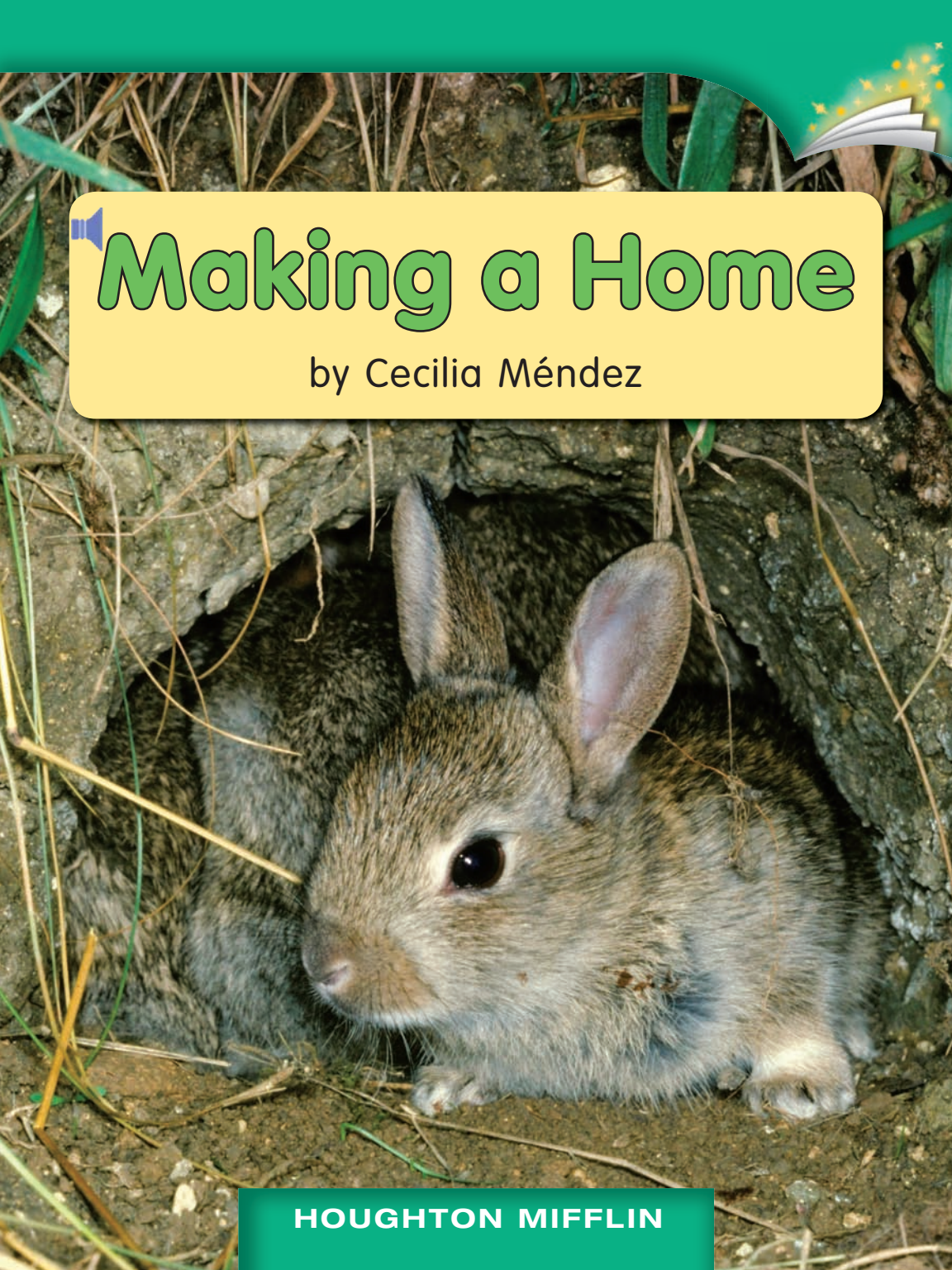

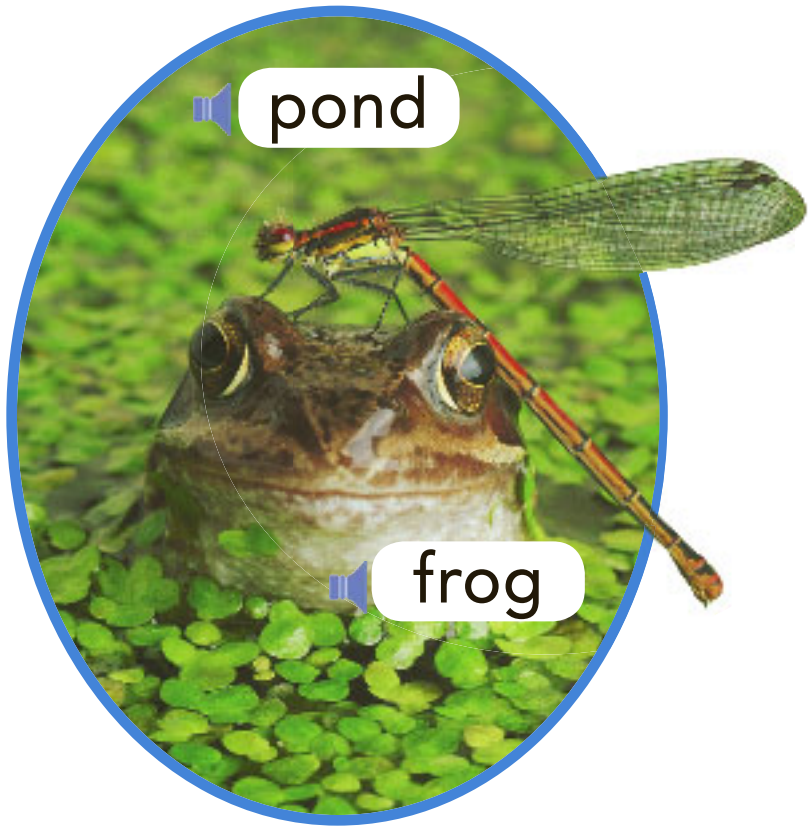


Bees get their food from flowers.

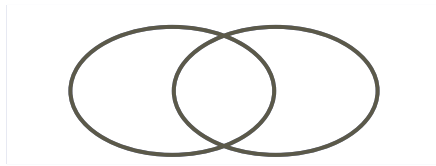
