For those scholarships with extra selection requirements listed, all applications will still be considered but preference may be given to those applicants who meet the special selection requirements.

Chuck E. McIntyre Memorial Scholarship

- Preference given to students entering Forestry or Construction trades

L David & Janice Horner Family Scholarship

- Preference given to major in Agriculture, Business, or Music

Cody McFarland Memorial Scholarship

- Preference given to major in Automotive or Metal Fabrication

Tim & JoAnn McQueary Scholarship

- Preference given to major in School of Engineering, Technology, Science, and/or Medical Field

Virginia M. Dossler Scholarship

- Preference given to Legal, Accounting, Technical or Nursing

Norm & Donna Davis Memorial Scholarship

- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must be a 4-year wrestler with minimum of 2 years at SHHS
- 2 letters of reference from community members and 2 letters of reference from school personnel

Loren & Ev Emmert Family Scholarship

- Preference given to majors in Medical or Education

Donald O and Texas L Driggs Community Service Scholarship

- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- **Provide one-page letter** that describes your volunteer work and commitment to community service

Greg Hagle Memorial Scholarship

- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must have participated in sports at Sweet Home HS

Keesecker Family Scholarship

- Preference given to students enrolling in a Christian College or in Biblical studies

Walraven-Schirmer Scholarship

- Must be pursuing a degree in the fields of Education or Human Health Care Services

Baumgartner Family Scholarship

- Preference given to students majoring in the fields of Education or Forestry

Lawrence Parker Scholarship

- Preference given to students entering Medical or Business fields

Sweet Home Alumni Family Member

- Parent, grandparent or legal guardian must be SHHS Alumni

Chuck Smith Memorial

- Minimum 2.0 GPA
- Preference given to Law Enforcement majors
- Must attend a Community College
- If Law Enforcement major, one additional letter of recommendation from an active or retired person in Law Enforcement or Corrections must be included.
- If Law Enforcement major, include a brief statement regarding why applicant wishes to seek a career in Law Enforcement and/or Corrections

Robbie Melcher Memorial Scholarship Fund

- Preference given to applicants going into forestry and/or forestry engineering and/or applicants whose parents or family members worked in the logging industry

Fun Forest, Inc. Scholarship

- Preference given to applicants going into forestry and/or forestry engineering and/or applicants whose parents or family members worked in the logging industry

Casey "KC" Hanscam Memorial Scholarship

- Minimum 2.50 GPA
- Preference given to majors in Literature
- Preference to participants in Soccer or Track

Pat & Ernie Baxter Memorial Scholarship

- Must be a male wrestler with at least 3 years of experience, some at varsity level, for SHHS

Carlson Family Scholarship

- Preference given to students majoring in the fields of Education or Business

Melissa Klumph Scholarship

- Preference given to majors in Education

Sweet Home Alumni Kiwanis

- Minimum 2.0 GPA
- Preference given to Key Club members

Tony & Shelly Larson Scholarship

- Preference given to majors in Applied Life or Physical Science

- Dean McQueen Memorial Scholarship**
 - Student must be majoring in the fields of Counseling, Psychology, or Information Technology
 - Minimum 3.5 GPA

- Grace Patch Scholarship**
 - Preference given to male students taking college classes that prepares the student for a trade or business. Must be attending Linn-Benton Community College. Renewable for a 2nd year, if qualified.

- Maureen Scanlon Haynes Scholarship**
 - Preference given to students showing strong financial need. EFC must be shown on the application
 - Applicant must complete a less than 500 word statement demonstrating financial need
 - Minimum 3.0 GPA

- Keith Gabriel Memorial Scholarship**
 - Preference given to students entering the field of Education

2023 Criteria for SHAF Scholarships

Application Deadline: April 7, 2023

AWARD AMOUNT:

- May vary. Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, books and/or fees at an accredited community college, college, university, or technical school in the United States.

WHO MAY APPLY?

- Sweet Home High School graduating seniors with an end of first semester accumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher. (Exception: 3.0 GPA for the Norm Davis, D. & T. Driggs, Maureen Scanlon Haynes, and Greg Hagle Scholarships; 2.50 for Casey “KC” Hanscam Scholarship; 2.0 for Chuck Smith and SH Kiwanis Scholarships).
- Applicants must have attended classes on the Sweet Home High School campus.
- All applicants must be a legal U.S. resident.

CONDITIONS OF AWARDS:

- Each applicant must have applied to an accredited community college, college, university or technical school in the United States and be enrolled full time when the scholarship is dispersed.
- The Scholarship award will be sent to the educational institution at the beginning of the academic year. The institution will disperse the award in equal allotments based upon that institution’s academic year. (i.e., semester/quarter).
- If for any reason the recipient of this award is not able to attend the educational institution for any part of the year for which the award is made, all unused monies awarded will be returned to the Sweet Home Alumni Foundation. **We will not allow any extensions past the award year!**
- Applicants must be available for a personal interview.
- Applicants need to have completed the FAFSA form prior to enrollment at the accredited community college, college, university or technical school
- Return of the “Scholarship Acceptance Form” **by August 1st** following high school graduation. **This form must be received before scholarship funds are disbursed.**

COMPLETED APPLICATION INCLUDES:

- SHAF Scholarship Application Form (Must be typed and printed as one-sided format)
- Two letters of reference from non-family members, (or more, if a scholarship requires additional letters).
- Resume that lists all activities student has participated in during the past four years and awards or honors received including work history, community, school, church, leadership experiences, participation in specific organizations, skills, hobbies, interests and any other extra-curricular activities.
- Copy of High School transcript through first semester.
- **Any additional information required as stated under scholarship name on page 2 and/or 3.** (Volunteer essay for Driggs Scholarship, additional letters of recommendation, financial need statement, etc.)

SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

- Applications may be submitted to the Sweet Home Alumni Foundation, PO Box 83, Sweet Home, OR 97386 or dropped off with Mrs. Adams at the SHHS Career Center. All applications **must** be received on or before **APRIL 7, 2023. INCOMPLETE OR LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**
